The position is responsible for facilitating the coordination, preparation, submission, and attainment of registrations and re-registrations to support global product registrations and defense to the Agriculture, Public Health and Forestry businesses in a manner that reflects appropriate levels of strategic design and implementation.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Work with Manager and other members of the global Regulatory Affairs team to prepare and submit applications for new product registrations and new uses and other amendments for current product re-registrations.
- Participate in project meetings and R&D reviews.
- Assist with data call-ins and other information requests from regulatory agencies.
- Assist in the development of strategies for obtaining registrations in target countries, including timelines and costs for achievement of registrations in line with business objectives.
- Stay informed of current regulations to help ensure company is compliance.
- Participation in peer review of studies to determine possible regulatory implications.
- Maintain knowledge of current new pesticide regulatory policies and decisions.
- Assist in the preparation of SDSs.
