

The CABI BioProtection Portal

- An open access, web-based tool that enables users to correctly identify, source and apply registered biocontrol and biopesticide products against agricultural pests
- Also provides general information on biological control and IPM via blogs and other resources





The CABI BioProtection Portal: Key Users

- Multiple potential users:
 - ➤ **Growers and advisors** who need current and reliable information, on-demand, regarding the availability and correct use of effective, lower toxicity products that are registered locally and meet market/export standards
 - National authorities responsible for regulation/registration of plant protection products who require information on registered products in neighbouring countries
 - ➤ **Biocontrol manufacturers** looking to promote wider uptake of their products and identify new markets

Permission to use national governmental datasets

- Our bioprotection product information is sourced directly from national and regional governments' lists of registered plant protection products.
- Permission to use data is always requested from the national authority responsible for the registration of plant protection products, and links to the authority websites are displayed on the portal.
- Data updated manually on a regular basis.

Three major classes of biopesticides as defined by the EPA:


- **Biochemical pesticides -** Naturally occurring substances that control pests by non-toxic mechanisms. E.g. sex pheromones and plant extracts that attract insects
- Microbial pesticides Product where active ingredient is a microorganism. E.g. bacteria, fungi, and viruses
- Plant-Incorporated-Protectants (PIPs) Substances that plants produce from genetic material that was added to the plant DNA. E.g. Bacillus thuringiensis pesticidal protein

Macrobial products are only included in the CABI BioProtection Portal for **partner** companies. These products must have been approved by USDA APHIS¹


 Navigate to desired country homepage and select language, occupation, crop and/or pest


 Search results display all registered products in the US for the selected crop-pest combination. Can further filter for state.






Detailed product information

- Crop-specific resources in the pipeline for 2023






Making end-users aware of the portal










Searches by crop

Funding mechanism to guarantee open access

Portal must receive funds to ensure it is maintained enhanced as an open access, up-to-date and reliable global source for bioprotection information:

- Partnership (e.g. private sector biocontrol manufacturers, distributors, etc.)
 - 3-year commitment via a fixed annual partnership fee based on annual bioprotection product revenue (fee ranging from USD 830 to USD 22,080 annually)
- Sponsorship (e.g. private sector stakeholders)
 - 3-year commitment via annual sponsorship fee determined by the size of the company (based on OECD definitions)
- Donorship (e.g. governmental development agencies)
 - Contributions from governmental agencies based on their priorities, focus countries, and funding schemes
