

BPIA MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Complete this application to apply for membership in BPIA. The BPIA Membership Committee will confirm that the applying company meets the requirements for membership at the appropriate level and will recommend prospective new members to the BPIA Board of Directors for final approval.

Membership: All member companies are eligible to vote in elections of the board of directors and on any policies, positions, or issues brought before the membership by the board. Membership dues are based on international annual gross revenue generated within the biological products industry, as defined by BPIA. Revenue may come from biopesticide, biostimulant, or biofertilizer product sales, active ingredient sales, or raw materials or input sales to biological products manufacturing companies, or services such as consulting, toll manufacturing, distribution, or other services provided to biological product companies deemed appropriate by BPIA. Please determine your company's membership category and dues level from the information provided below.

Membership Categories

- **Manufacturer**: Is a company that manufacturers any biological products including biopesticide, biofertilizer or biostimulant products or holds a registration of any such biological product.
- 2. Non-Manufacturer: Is a company that does not manufacture any biological products and does not hold a registration of any biological product. This category includes allied material manufacturers and formulation material providers to the biological products industry as well as toll manufacturers. This category includes marketers or distributors of any biological products. This category includes service providers to the biological products industry, not limited to financial, marketing, regulatory, laboratory, legal, and research services.
- **3. Grower or Food Processor**: Is a company that grows plants or agricultural products for commercial sale or food processor combining raw food ingredients to produce marketable food products and not holding any biological product registrations.
- **4. Affiliate**: Is a company which is an affiliate or subsidiary of a member of any category with annual gross revenue generated within the biological products industry that is already accounted for in the revenue of that other member.
- 5. Sole Proprietor: Is a company eligible for membership in any category with two or fewer full-time employees.

BPIA members will use scientifically-valid efficacy tests when supporting claims and promotions.

BPIA members will use commercially-acceptable product efficacy levels in target geography with minimal field trial variability.
